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<p>Parent Comments:</p> <p>→ Generally, there was an overwhelming view that the Covid response at Stratford NS is well planned, structured and operated.</p> <p>→ 1-way system mostly works well</p> <p>→ Provision of handwashing and sanitisation facilities is good</p> <p>→ Morning arrival well managed with someone physically on duty to keep people moving, and the larger of the two black gates left open so it does not have to be touched</p>	<p>→ Main concern is the end of day arrangements where parents arrive and children are leaving.</p> <p>→ Bottleneck at the small pedestrian gate (particularly bad on 2pm Fridays.)</p> <p>→ Parking on the footpath outside the school blocking path</p> <p>→ Frequency of hand washing maintained.</p> <p>→ Cold water hand washing at outdoor sinks</p> <p>→ Some reports of hand rashes from using the school sanitiser</p> <p>→ Hose tap snagging clothing</p>	<p>→ Open a pedestrian access way through Herzog Park</p> <p>→ Staggering of finishing times</p> <p>→ Use of the Large car gate to enable a 1-way system</p> <p>→ Big black gate be left open in the afternoon like it is in the morning</p> <p>→ Staff member "on duty" to keep people moving</p> <p>→ Remind parents to keep moving</p> <p>Other Queries:</p> <p>→ Cold water hand washing outside in winter?</p> <p>→ People parking on the footpath?</p> <p>→ Review sanitiser supplier & brand</p> <p>→ Willing parents be drafted in to help</p>	<p>Communicate the following to parents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not to 'bump up' on path on Zion Rd & comply with double yellow lines • Use pedestrian gate when entering school and exit via the large car gate • Exercise social distancing and leave the school grounds quickly when dropping & collecting <p>→ Herzog Park entrance has been requested, waiting for DCC</p> <p>→ Use hand santiser rather than cold water outdoor taps in winter</p> <p>→ Possible review sanitiser supplier & brand</p>	<p>→ Letter will be sent to parents</p> <p>→ PA to reinforce Covid compliance measures in their communications</p> <p>→ If parking issue persists, get cones for along Zion Road</p> <p>→ Ask parent volunteers to put the cones out</p> <p>→ Reinforce entering through pedestrian and exiting through the car gate and have a staff presence at 3pm</p> <p>→ Sanitiser must be procured from agreed DES companies.
