## Agreed Report of the Board of Management

The Board of Management is unable to share everything discussed at a Board meeting from a confidentiality point of view but here's the summary what was discussed at our meeting in September 2025.

<b>Date of Board of Management Meeting</b>	<b>17<sup>th</sup> September 2025</b>
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*Information for parents, staff and the school community following the meeting of the Board of Management.*

- The Chairperson of the Board of Management welcomed the Board and thanked them for their presence.
- The minutes of the previous board meetings were approved and signed.
- Correspondence
  - The application for Additional Accommodation has been received by the Department of Education and Youth and they will be in touch.
- The Chairperson presented her report including:
  - An update in relation to electrical works at the school. Electrical works are still ongoing, with items such as the water heaters, intercom and the cable to the prefab outstanding.
  - Funding for the firestopping in the school has been approved and it has gone to tender.
  - The funding for the structural emergency works application is still being discussed with the Department of Education and Youth, as they have not approved the full amount sought to repair the walls.
  - The Board is advocating for a full grant and has submitted further documentation to the Department
- The Principal presented her report including updates related to:
  - The Child Protection Oversight Report and Anti-bullying Report.
  - Enrolments for September 2025.
  - Parental feedback received on the Bf Cineálta policy has been reviewed and incorporated into the policy. The staff are currently reviewing the changing prior to ratification by the BOM
  - The school is fully staffed following interviews over the summer.
  - The school will begin to work on a Dignity at Work policy
  - Autism Classes Working Group – Mr Ben Marcus is the BOM representative. Ms Healy will organise a rep from the Early Intervention class and the date of the first meeting.
  - A school secretary, Joanne McAuliffe has been appointed for 12.5 hours per week.
- The Treasurer of the BOM presented a financial update on all school budgets.
  - Approval was given to purchase replacement teacher laptops from the IT grant.
